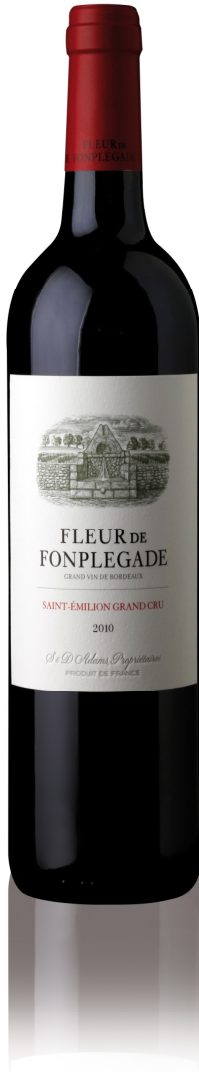


FLEUR DE FONPLEGADE SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU 2010
