**Appellation:** Rattlesnake Hills

### Winemaker Notes

**The Wine:** *Planted in 1983, the 4 acre Block 2 is our oldest Cabernet Sauvignon planting; as the vines have matured the fruit has grown in vitality and depth. This special block 2 designated wine exhibits classic black currant nose, subtle flavors, complex tannins, and brilliant color and balance. The wine will age beautifully or can be enjoyed now.*

**Food Matches:** *This wine calls for sharp cheeses, juicy steaks, or rack of lamb.*

**Descriptors:** *Savory dark fruit, black cherry, blackberry.*

**Brix at Harvest:** 24.1° Brix

**T.A.:** .75 g/100mL

**Alcohol:** 14.2%

**Varietal Mix:** 100% Block 2 Cabernet Sauvignon
